THE GLENS FALLS PROJECT IS FULLY FUNDED!

It's been a long time coming!

You know how it is when you have to wait for something good? It's hard! Well, at the Sound of Life we've waited for a long time to be able to say this: **The Glens Falls (90.7 FM) transmitter project is fully funded and we've placed the order for the new equipment!**

Though the waiting has been hard, one of the very exciting things is that the cost of the transmitter actually dropped—so the total project is going to cost quite a bit less than the original estimate. God is so good and we've been rejoicing over this unexpected way that God has worked! Though the funds are in place and the equipment has been ordered, there will be a bit more waiting...waiting for the actual work to be completed. We had hoped it would happen before the end of 2017, but the only access road to the transmitter on Prospect Mountain near Lake George is closed for the winter. When it's safe to access the site in the spring, our engineers will be able to work.

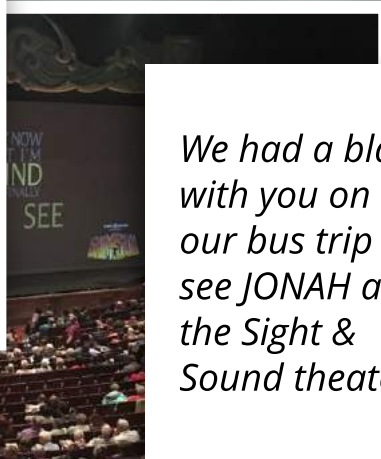
We're going to have a lot to celebrate when the wait is over and Glens Falls goes from 45 watts to 650 watts! The Sound of Life has the potential to reach at least 50,000 more people when that upgrade happens. We've also been waiting to upgrade two other transmitters – Monroe (89.3 FM) and Liberty (88.1 FM). These upgrades will allow us to reach even more people with the love, hope, and encouragement that come from the music and messages on the Sound of Life each day! The transmitter upgrade fund will remain open until the day when we'll be able to say that those projects are fully funded as well. We're so thankful to so many of you who have already given to this fund and we look forward with great anticipation to seeing what God will do through His work through these transmitters! ❤️
