PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS

In addition to the many public service announcements aired for local churches & other not-for-profit organizations, the following aired:

SELECTIVE SERVICE :30 – Info about and encouraging young men to sign up for Selective Service. Airls approximately 4-5 times per week. Started on June 16, 2018.

FAITH HOUSE :60 – Info about and encouraging support for Faith House, a residence for expectant single mothers set to open in 2017. 2 – 3X per day throughout the quarter.
